Catechetical Series On Topics Related to Bishops on Diocesan YouTube Channel

In preparation for the ordination and installation of our new Bishop, W. Shawn McKnight, the ordination planning committee commissioned the diocesan communications office to work with Fr. Dan Merz, Chair of the Liturgical Commission, to create a catechetical video series to educate the faithful about the episcopacy in the Catholic Church.

Ten separate topics are planned to be addressed. The first: "What is a Diocese and How is a Bishop Selected?" & the second: "What is the Relationship of a Bishop to his Priests and Deacons?". Others are: "The Qualities of a Bishop as Presented in the New Testament," "The Cathedral (Cathedra) and Its Symbolism," "The Relationship of a Bishop to the Pope and the College of Bishops," "The Relationship of a Bishop to the Laity," and "The History and Significance of the Coat of Arms and Motto of the Bishop."
