## From the Pastor:

**Many thanks:** On January 15<sup>th</sup>, the thanksgiving Mass followed by Appreciation dinner brought in a good number of people. It was a moment of saying thanks to God who enabled us to do all that we did collectively for the good of the Parish and of School. It was also a moment to appreciate all those who have been involved in different ministries and services of the Parish. When we look at what we did individually, we might realize that we have not done much but when we take everything together and view it collectively, we might realize that truly we have done great for the glory of God. Once again, I extend my thanks to all who have been doing different ministries and rendering services for the good of the Parish. I appreciate and say a big thank you to Barb Adrian, Karen Schulte and Roxanne Schulte for planning and organizing the event very well putting in a great deal of hard work. I also thank all those who generously provided different dishes to the meal which, of course, brought in good varieties to everyone's liking and that made the dinner really sumptuous.

**Healing Service:** I am really concerned about quite many of our parish family members are having health issues or having medical procedures for serious illnesses. It has been in mind for a while to conduct a parish healing service. Now I realize that it is time proper to do one on February 5, Tuesday at evening Mass. It will be done after Holy Communion followed by anointing. All those who desire healing are most welcome.

So as to be prepared for the service, I am giving you the following guidelines that are generally followed based on the Word of God:

### Disposition:

- A. **Faith in Jesus Christ.** "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not seen" (Heb: 11, 1)
- B. **Believe that you have already received.** "Therefore I tell you, all that you ask for in prayer, believe that you will receive it and it shall be yours. (Mk 11:24). "Whatever you ask for in prayer with faith, you will receive" ( Mt 21:22)
- C. **Forgiving heart.** "When you stand to pray, forgive anyone against whom you have a grievance, so that your heavenly father may in turn forgive you your transgressions ( Mk 11:25 - 26) – sacrament of confession is recommended
- D. **Earnest desire** for healing and wellness (Mt. 14:34 – 36)

### Jesus is the healer:

- A. "He took away our infirmities and bore our diseases" (Mt 8:17)
- B. "He was pierced for our offenses, crushed for our sins" (Is.53:5)
- C. "He himself bore our sins in his body upon the cross, so that free from sin we might live for righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.(1Pet. 2:24)

The healing can be instant in some cases and other cases it can take a process. It would grow like a seed (Mk 4:14). However, just be aware that the devil can take away the seed (Mk 4, 15) by bringing in doubts, questions and distractions.

**World Day for Consecrated Life will be celebrated in the Church on Saturday, Feb. 2, and in parishes on the weekend of Feb. 2-3. Please pray for all those who have made commitments in the consecrated life, and be sure to thank them on their special day. May they continue to be inspired by Jesus Christ and respond generously to God's gift of their vocation.**
