From the Pastor:

Appreciation and thanks: I appreciate so much those PSR kids who did wonderful ministries on February 24, at Sunday Mass. They really brought much joy in to the liturgy. I appreciate their parents and teachers for encouraging them and guiding them to do such service. I extend my thanks to Fr. Kevin Gormley for offering the Masses on the first weekend of March. I appreciate his kind services to our Parish.

Start of Lent: It starts on March 6 with Ash Wednesday. On this day, we have got two Masses – one is at 8 am and the other is at 7 pm. It is a day of fasting and abstinence.

Fasting & Abstinence: During Lent, Catholic Church has set two days for fasting & abstinence – one is on Ash Wednesday and other is on Good Friday. However, all Fridays are meant for practicing abstinence. (Please refer to the regulations given by the diocese)

Meaning of Lent: With a day of fasting and abstinence, we enter into the season of lent. The word '**Lent**' means spring time which indeed is referred to a time of spiritual renewal. In order to attain this state of grace, we have been given three – fold scripture based practices. They are: **1. Praying. 2. Fasting. 3. Almsgiving** - for details, please refer to the diocesan guidelines.

Stations of the Cross: On Fridays, Stations of the Cross will be held at 2.15 pm by the school and at 7 pm by the parish. It is a spiritual journey we make with Jesus walking his way to Calvary mediating on His passion and death. Our Church encourages everyone to participate in it.

Rice Bowl: We are also called to support the hungry world by filling in the Rice Bowl that will be **given out on the weekend of the first Sunday of Lent**. Your generous sacrifices will reflect on the bowls when they are filled and handed in before Easter. Parents may kindly encourage their kids to take one to fill in with the money they would generally spend on buying ice cream or candy. It would be a wonderful sacrifice they would make for the less fortunate children living in the third world countries.

Other Lenten practices by USCCB: There are other good practices suggested in the bulletin insert titled '**Daily Inspiration for your Lenten Journey**'. Every day has been marked with one or two activities. It is a wonderful exercise so as to be in tune with the spirit of Lent.

Lenten regulations & admonitions by the diocese:

As another Lenten journey of conversion begins on Ash Wednesday, March 6 and ends with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 18, Holy Mother Church calls all Catholics to a deeper spirit of penance, fasting, almsgiving, prayer and worship, "which express conversion in relation to oneself, to God, and to others" (Catechism of the Catholic Church # 1434 & 1969).

In order to foster a greater spirit of penance, of reparation for sin, to encourage self-denial, Catholics are reminded of the following obligations of fast and abstinence that are part the proper observance of Lent.

1.) Abstinence: All persons who have already celebrated their 14th birthday are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

2.) Fasting: Everyone, from the celebration of their 18th birthday to their 59th birthday, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting is generally understood to mean eating only one full meal each day. Two other partial meals, sufficient to maintain strength, may be taken; but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids are allowed. Other forms of fasting, as regards alcoholic drink, needless television, videogames, Internet use and social entertainment, are of true spiritual value and strongly encouraged.

3.) Almsgiving: All Catholics are encouraged to support the charitable works of the whole Church through giving to their parish and support of other charities.

4.) Prayer: In order to deepen one's love for Christ, Catholics are urged to participate in the sacramental life of the Church during Lent by attending daily Mass and frequent the sacrament of penance and reconciliation.

Lenten Parish Mission: As announced earlier, Parish Mission begins on March 13, Wednesday at 6.30 pm and goes up to March 15, Friday. It will end with communal penance service on the last day. It is a three - evening program extending to 45 minutes each and on the last day, it would take a little longer time because of the penance service. Please spare your good time for this spiritual food designed by God for our parish. There will be a free-will offering taken on the last day to support the mission of Fr. Eugene Hensell, the Mission Preacher. Please come prepared with your generous heart.
