From the Pastor:

On June 27th Tuesday, Pastoral Council had its monthly meeting. It was my first meeting. Besides, the members, I had invited Roxanne Schulte and Joshua Vandike to the meeting. Hereafter, the Principal of the School will be a member of the PC as he/she will be the link between the Parish and School. And also, there will be a representative from PC at the School Board meeting. This way the Parish and school will be well connected.

As a policy, I would like to maintain transparency with the Parishioners on all aspects of different meetings and so the minutes of all the meetings will be given out as bulletin insert. This will give you all an idea about how things are going on in the Parish.

As part of an ongoing catechesis in the Parish, I intend to have two Parish Missions, a small one (1 – 2 evenings) in fall and a big one (three evenings) during lent. Alongside, the parents who desire Baptism for their babies will be given some preparation class along with the godparents prior to the sacrament. It might be 30 to 40 minutes session on an evening to be done either by the Pastor or the Deacon depending upon who does the Baptism. Within the given time frame, I can possibly do it on Saturdays and the Deacon can do it on Sundays. All baptisms will be done after Mass and so the Parents and Godparents will have to attend Mass.

Hereafter, at weekend masses, the introduction will be given by the celebrant and the petitions/mass intention and announcements will be done by the assisting Deacon. In his absence, the lector at Mass will do it.

The Principal reported that two new positions at School have already been filled in. I do welcome them to the school and wish them well. It was also reported that the proposed roof replacement on the old school building will be delayed. It is likely to be done during the school days.

At the meeting, I felt the need of an orientation to be given for all members of Pastoral Council, Finance Council and of School Board to know their role and function. This will be jointly conducted by Sr. Kathleen, the Chancellor and Deacon Joe Braddock, the finance officer of the diocese. It will be done on one evening lasting for 1- 2 hours. The date and time will be set after meeting with them.

Now it is time to work on time and talent. As part of stewardship to the Parish, I would like each member of the Parish to sign up for different ministries/ works. For this purpose, time and talent sheet will be placed on the pews with pencils/pens at the weekend Masses of July 14th & 15th. It will be individual based not family based. As you take your seat in the church, please take a good look at the sheet of paper. Then, as the Holy Spirit inspires you, please sign up your name for the ministries/ works that you intend to give your time and talent. I would also like the kids from 3rd grade on to sign up for Mass serving. They will be given training at a convenient time.

Finally, as a Pastor, I would like to know what is being done by different groups for the good of the Parish. Hence, I would like to meet with them separately on an evening. Please call the office and fix up a time either on Tuesday or Wednesday evening.
