From the Pastor: Having observed briefly on the nature of readings done by Lectors at Mass, I thought of writing some guidelines for doing effective and meaningful reading.

A. Preparation: (1) Remember that you are going to read the **Word of God** as though God is going to speak to His people through you. (2) When you read from the books of Prophet or other books from the Old Testament, you would become either a Prophet or a Writer and when you do it from the New Testament, you would become either Paul or John or Peter or a writer. (3) You must pray and prepare well - prayer could be **'Lord I am going to read your word at Mass today and help me to do well through your spirit'**. (4) When you prepare the reading, please try to get the meaning of the difficult words and the right pronunciation of the names that would figure in the text – for help, please log on to www.usccb.org and click on **'Readings Audio'**. (5) At least a couple of days before you read, try to have a mental picture that you are reading well and others are listening attentively. And also keep saying to yourself **'I can read well and I will read well'**.

B. Reading actual: (1) When you stand before the **lector's stand**, please make sure that the microphone is closer to your mouth. Try to read into the microphone for everyone to hear and understand what you are reading. (2) **Please pause** after you have read, 'a reading from the letter of St. Paul to the Romans' and then after you have finished reading the passage, that is, before you say 'the word of the Lord'. (3) Please do not drop your tone at the last word of each sentence. (4) The names must be pronounced well and place emphasis on the verb where necessary. (5) Try to have variation in your tone; suppose there is a quote 'then the tone will change or someone is saying something to someone in the reading, then tone will change, too. The tone of reading will be staying steady and rising & falling. (6) Do have eye contact' once in the beginning, a couple of times in between and once at the end when you say 'the word of the Lord'.

C. Points to remember: (1) Please remember that those sitting in the church are your family people and friends. (2) It is very natural to be nervous when you stand before a big congregation - when you do feel nervous say to your mind **'it is all fine.'**(3) When reading, try to put on a cheerful face - a gentle smile on your face will take away your nervousness. (4) Never feel bad about mistakes and our God will not take you to task. He knows that we are weak and imperfect and He is using us to proclaim His word. (5) Always desire to become a good reader and so observe those who read well and you will discover new things - remember each one has got a style and never copy others and be yourself. (6) Do some evaluation after Mass with your trustworthy persons - pick up the positive aspects and then look for the areas of improvement. If anyone so desires, I can give a feedback.

Please remind yourself as often as you can of this beautiful Bible verse **"I can do everything through Christ who strengthens me"** (Phil. 4:13) Yes! You can do everything with the help of Jesus Christ, for He is God with us.

Finally, I would like all liturgical ministers chiefly, the lectors and Eucharistic ministers dress moderately. When they do not dress appropriately, the attention of the congregation will naturally be drawn to their style of dress and will take away the real focus from God, and Jesus. Let us all make effort to make improvement in this regard in such a way that we help each other to remain focused on the word of God and altar during Mass.
