**From the Pastor:** Last week, I did give you all some guidelines on how to do readings at Mass. This week, I would like to focus on the aspect of **reverence** and **attention** to be given at Mass. Every Mass is a reliving experience of the sacrifice that Jesus offered on the cross on mount Calvary for the entire humanity which is made alive on the Altar. It is an unfolding of the mystery of the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. And so, we are invited to enter into this mystery by participating in every aspect of the Mass.

By virtue of baptism, we become the priestly people of God sharing in the priesthood of Jesus Christ to offer and participate in the sacrifice of Jesus Christ. Mass being the celebration of the community, everyone has to maintain prayerful atmosphere and help one another to be attentive and focused. Hence, **‘no distraction’** whatsoever may be caused that would take away the attention from the altar. You are to listen attentively to what the priest is saying and doing on the altar chiefly to the sacred moment from **epiclesis**, that is invoking the Spirit of the Lord upon the offerings to **doxology**, that is ‘through Him, with Him’ and ending with singing, **‘Amen’**. This period of time is most sacred, because it begins with the last supper then moves on to passion, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Therefore, at this time, please do not move about, walk over to rest room or take your kids out. Any movement by anyone at this time will take the focus out of this sacred moment. Parents with kids will have to be prepared to get all the natural calls done before this sacred time. If your kids are uncontrollable, it is advisable to take the back pews for the sake of others who are attentive at Mass. Hereafter, one pew on the right and one on the left will be reserved for the mothers with babies. If anyone feels distracted, please keep your eyes closed which I do. It helps me to be conscious of what I am doing and be focused.

Then, the celebration moves on to **Communion rite**. Here too, the same reverence will continue when you line up to receive Holy Communion until you return to your seat and remain in union with the Lord in thanksgiving. Now, the Communion Ministers place an important role. I propose them the following norms to follow:

(1) Please walk up to the altar after the priest has received the body and blood of Jesus Christ and remain recollected. (2) When you distribute Holy Communion or the cup, please be conscious and believe in what you are doing - **‘you are doing the ministry of Jesus’** when He gave bread and fish to the apostles to distribute to the people at the time of multiplication of loaves. (3) Please maintain reverence and silence right through. The way you distribute either the cup or Holy Communion will reveal your belief in the Eucharist. This will also vibrate with those who receive the Lord. (4) After you have done the ministry, please walk over to the credence table and consume the left over precious blood and leave the place recollected. (5) If you are distributing Holy Communion, you will have to purify your hands before and after distribution. All purification of sacred vessels will be done after Mass either by the Mass Coordinator or the deacon.
