From the Pastor: This weekend, I am sharing a thought – provoking reflection so as to be focused on Jesus and reorganize our lives centered on Him looking into the given questions:

IF JESUS CAME TO YOUR HOUSE TODAY . . .

If Jesus came to your home to spend a day or two If He came unexpectedly, I wonder what you'd do.

Oh, I know you'd give your nicest room to such an Honoured Guest,
 And all the food you'd serve him would be the very best,
 And you would keep reassuring Him you're glad to have Him there. That serving Him in your home, is joy beyond compare.

But when you saw Him coming, would you meet Him at the door
 With arms outstretched in welcome to your Heavenly Visitor?

Or would you have to change your clothes before you let Him in,
 Or hide some magazines, and put the Bible where they'd been?

Would you turn off the radio and hope He hadn't heard. And wish you hadn't uttered that last, loud hasty word?

Would you hide your worldly music and put some hymn books out?
 Could you let Jesus walk right in, or would you rush about?

And I wonder if the Saviour spent a day or two with you, Would you go on doing the things you always do? Would you go on saying the things you always say? Would life for you continue as it does from day to day?
