From the Pastor:

When the myth that the Church has too much money troubled you, look to the statistics that prove that the Catholic Church is the largest Charitable Organization on the face of the Earth. •

When you think that the Clergy are all crooks, remember that most of them are good guys that have sacrificed everything to give their life to the service of Christ and His Holy Church. •

When you think that human beings have corrupted the Church, remember Christ - it's Founder "Mathew 16:18" and that nothing shall prevail against it! •

When you think the Church is misogynist, look to the Blessed Virgin Mary - the perfection of God's creation was a woman•

When you are sick of hearing of the negative things about the Church in the media think about the stories that go largely unnoticed because talking positively about Her will not make "headlines". •

When you think the Church is oppressive, remember it is one of the Only Institutions that stood up for Truth against waves of Nazism, Communism and other ideologies that killed and ruined the lives of millions. •

When you think the Church is unhealthy for society, remember it is Pro-Life, Pro-Family and Pro-Traditional Marriage! •

Brothers and Sisters in Christ, Our Church is about to head through some turbulent times, a time of purification so that we may continue to grow closer to Christ and rid the Holy Mother Church of all that tries to destroys it. Whilst this will prove to be painful, remain steadfast, stay close to the Sacraments, pray for and defend Holy priests, offer up prayer and penance, become more Eucharistic and have special devotion to Our Blessed Mother.
