## From the Pastor:

**A big thank you:** I do appreciate and thank you all for expressing your sincere sympathies, prayers and kind words over the sudden death of my religious sister Joachim. At the time of loss, these gestures of yours have eased my pain greatly. I have passed them all to my siblings and their families. Please continue to keep her and us all in your prayers. God will heal and ease such pain in His own time.

**Penance Service:** Our parish penance service will be held on December 12, Wednesday at 7 pm. There will be 4 priests to hear the confession. Hence, I request you all to participate in the sacrament of reconciliation in big numbers and be prepared spiritually for the celebration of Christmas and New Year.

As announced before, the second penance service for PSR kids (7 – 12) will be held on December 19 Wednesday at 6.45 pm. There will also be 4 priests to hear confession. It is a wonderful opportunity for the kids to receive the sacrament of reconciliation. And so, I request the teachers to prepare them well to receive the forgiveness of God and thus experience His peace and joy.

**Bombinelli Sunday:** It is done on third Sunday of Advent and a special Sunday when the images of baby Jesus will be blessed at both the Masses. By this time, each family would make a manger scene and bring the baby Jesus to the church to receive special blessing as announced in the bulletin. Hence, I request the PSR teachers and parents to encourage our kids to make a manger scene at home explaining to them the meaning of Jesus being born in a manger so as to relive the spirit of Christmas as Francis of Assisi started in 13<sup>th</sup> century.

**New Pictorial Directory:** In our last Pastoral Council meeting held on November 27, the members decided to work on a new Pictorial directory for the Parish with Mr. Phil Parrino, the Lifetouch man to bring out one in a handbook form. The proposed dates for pictures are **March 20,21,22,23 (Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday) and 26 & 27 (Tuesday, Wednesday) from 2 pm - 9 pm and on Saturday it will be 10 am - 5 pm.** Since, we booked these days in November, the parish would get a rebate of 5 %. Roxanne Schulte and Barb Adrian will coordinate the project. And so, I request you all to mark your convenient date and time in your calendar so that no one will be left out of our new parish directory.

**A regulation to follow:** I would like to have some clear regulation to be followed when you are to get baptism done for your babies. As before first please contact the Parish office and do the necessary preliminary paper work. Then the office will contact the Pastor with all the information on the paper and accordingly direction will be given to the Secretary with regard to the time and date for preparation and baptism. Baptism preparation needs time and it contains a number of things for instruction to the parents and god-parents. It is an ongoing catechesis given to families before babies are baptized and so it should not be taken lightly. Please remember preparation must take place after the child is born not before.
