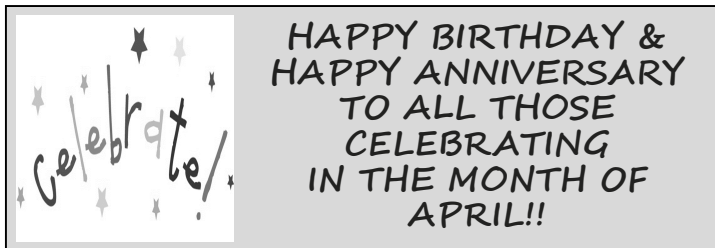

### FROM THE PASTOR:

#### Palm Sunday

Today, Palm Sunday, we begin the most important week of the liturgical year. After today we begin holy week during which we will commemorate, as we do every year, the sorrowful passion and the terrible death of our Lord.

As we meditate, we sometimes ask ourselves, has there been any man in history, except Jesus, who after 20 centuries is still remembered as our Lord? There is no doubt that during the history of humanity, there has been many famous people. But for the part, not long after their death they were forgotten. But Christ's presence is still with us today so much so that it is as if his passion was actually happening for the first time this week. And so, year after year we experience his death and also, of course, his glorious resurrection.

In life we meet various forms of suffering. Sometimes we tend to think that God had forsaken us. The truth is that some forms of suffering we pass through are meant to help us get to where God wants us to be. What God has prepared for you is more than what you think you are going through at the moment [ 1 cor. 2:9]. What is expected of us, is to allow Christ to Triumphantly enter into our lives. Like the guilty Barabbas imprisoned by sins, condemned to death, until the paschal lamb, the innocent Jesus Christ, appeared and granted him a surprising freedom, giving Barabbas liberation and accepting crucifixion.

We have reached the end of the Lenten season. This means that now we are called to accompany Jesus as He goes to Jerusalem. Confession of our sins, prayer, almsgiving and fasting are the means that we Christians, use to help us to meditate more deeply on the passion and death of our Lord.

### Better Together Pastoral Planning process

The Diocesan Pastoral Council met last Saturday and asked that the timeline for the discernment of parish pastoral plans be kept as much as possible. Small groups may meet virtually through video or tele-conferencing and submit discernment reports online, which will be forwarded to their proper pastor. The DPC also recommends a fifth week of discernment be added after the completion of the small group session on Parishes as Centers of Mercy. The fifth week would be used to assess the proposals the group has already made, and to highlight the more important two-four proposals they recommend. The deadline for small group submissions to parish councils is May 1; the deadline for parish pastoral plans being submitted to the chancery is July 1. #### Statement on Behalf of Cole County Public & Non-Public School Districts:

In an effort to collaborate across Cole County for the safety and well-being of students, families, and teachers, the educational leaders of both the public and non-public schools are taking a proactive step to help limit potential exposure opportunities. Cole County school leaders recognize we have overlapping constituencies with one another and have chosen this collaborative approach to work stronger together. In accordance with the recommendations of the health department, and to allow residents returning from Spring Break or other travel to meet the recommended 14-day self-quarantine, we feel it is necessary to extend our current district closure by one week to protect the health and well-being of our staff and students. **Therefore, all public and non-public schools in Cole County will reopen no earlier than Monday, April 13th.**
