FROM THE PASTOR:

Sunday of Divine Mercy

The Easter season marks a time of new beginning in the church. Its stories tell us that the resurrection is not something we fully understand, but it is something we should believe and live.

The disciples heard the reports of Jesus appearance to few women, like Mary after his resurrection, but they were still weak in faith. In fact, they were confused, afraid, faithless and lacked peace. From what happened when Jesus was arrested, the apostles lost every sign of order, they even lost hope. Peace went on vacation and they took refuge at the upper room where they locked the door for fear of the Jews. The risen Lord, continues to appear to them, helping them to understand that He is still alive over a period of time. In the gospel, Jesus came and stood with his disciples. He gave them peace and showed them his hands and his feet.

The resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ is the highest expression of Divine mercy. It started with His death on the cross which signals the paying of our debts and our liberation from sin and death. With God's mercy, we are called to show mercy and pardon to others. Our Lord in commissioning His apostles on this day told them to forgive sins; that is to grant pardon indicating that through the sacrament of penance our sins are forgiven and we are granted mercy and pardon. What a gratitude from our God that a sacrament of mercy has been given to us so that we will be saved of our sins. So having heard the good news, we are therefore called to bear witness to the Lord's resurrection, not only with the words of our mouth but with the very life we live. May the resurrection of Christ change the face of the earth to a new creation and help us rise above our limitations.

Better Together Pastoral Planning process

The Diocesan Pastoral Council met last Saturday and asked that the timeline for the discernment of parish pastoral plans be kept as much as possible. Small groups may meet virtually through video or tele-conferencing and submit discernment reports online, which will be forwarded to their proper pastor. The DPC also recommends a fifth week of discernment be added after the completion of the small group session on Parishes as Centers of Mercy. The fifth week would be used to assess the proposals the group has already made, and to highlight the more important two-four proposals they recommend. **The deadline for small group submissions to parish councils is May 1;** the deadline for parish pastoral plans being submitted to the chancery is July 1. Catholic schools in Diocese of Jefferson City will remain in distance learning mode through end of school year.

JEFFERSON CITY – In light of Governor Michael Parsons' announcement April 9 that all public schools in Missouri will remain closed through the end of the school year, the Diocese of Jefferson City's Catholic elementary and high schools will continue providing lessons through remote means so as to conclude their school year on May 15. Bishop W. Shawn McKnight will review the implications of this decision on the pastoral activities of the parishes and provide more guidance as soon as possible. All parishes and schools are abiding by a decree issued by Bishop McKnight on April 1, which restricts the type of public gatherings in the 95 parishes of the diocese through April 30.
