FROM THE PASTOR:

Third Sunday of Easter

Today's gospel passage is, in my opinion, among the best passages in the whole of the four gospels. Reason being, as we read through, we feel inspired. But soon after reading, we begin asking ourselves questions: Where is Emmaus? Why did the two disciples leave, even after hearing that something extraordinary had happened, and why did they not first verify what had really taken place? Why are we not told the name of the second disciple?

Dear friends, this story is deeper than it might seem on the surface. In many ways, this story teaches us truths about the spiritual life. Our spiritual life is a kind of journey, and on this journey, we are not alone. We have each other, but most importantly, we have Jesus-our God who is making the journey with us whether we are aware of it or not. And Jesus wants nothing more than to be with us, teach us, commune with us, guide us, and bring us closer to Himself.

Again, we can take the Emmaus Journey to be our individual journey of faith, marital life, place of work, vocation to a particular call. Maybe at the initial time, it created some sort of joy for us, but now we are walking away in doubts and indecision, as things are no longer the way we had thought. Know it that Jesus can use any form [like the stranger] to remind us how slow we are to think that life goes without ups and downs.

The two disciples are sad because they have witnessed the "failure" of their expectations. They had dreamed of a glorious and powerful king, a political liberator of Israel, rather than the suffering Servant of God.

Like the disciples today, we are on our journey of faith, oftentimes full of failure and false hopes. Too often we get kind of lazy, weary from the challenges of life. Sometimes, we stop searching. We stop asking. We stop wondering about the mysteries of life. We stop listening. We stop following probably because of distractions of our day-to-day lives. Jesus is telling us today that, He is willing to participate in our discussion and be our guide in our journey.

Don't forget the tub in the vestibule of Church for those less fortunate.

Better Together Pastoral Planning process

The Diocesan Pastoral Council met last Saturday and asked that the timeline for the discernment of parish pastoral plans be kept as much as possible. Small groups may meet virtually through video or tele-conferencing and submit discernment reports online, which will be forwarded to their proper pastor. The DPC also recommends a fifth week of discernment be added after the completion of the small group session on Parishes as Centers of Mercy. The fifth week would be used to assess the proposals the group has already made, and to highlight the more important two-four proposals they recommend. **The deadline for small group submissions to parish councils is May 1;** the deadline for parish pastoral plans being submitted to the chancery is July 1.
