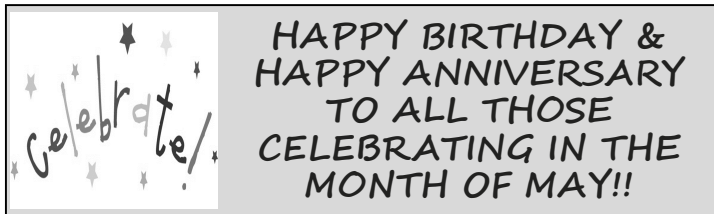

FROM THE PASTOR: GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

In the Gospel of John today, Jesus declared that He is the Good Shepherd who not only loves and cares for us, but also lays down His life. As the sheep of Christ, we must make constant efforts to learn about our Shepherd-the Christ. Also, being the sheep of Christ's flock, we must be familiar with His voice. One of the important ways to learn about Christ is to read the scriptures. Let's take it that we do recognize the voices of our friends, relatives, neighbors, co-workers, families, news casters. It is presumed we spend a lot of time with them at workplace, listening to them and so on. We only need a few words from them and we know who it is. But imagine not talking with them for years and then one day hearing their voice, they would seem like strangers. So, in today's gospel we hear about the Good Shepherd and how the sheep recognize the shepherd's voice and follow him. But will run away from a stranger's voice because they do not know him.

Dear friends, we are called to recognize the voice of our Good shepherd and to always follow him. And we do this by spending quality time in prayer each day, reading the bible, learning the sound of his voice, so when he calls us we will follow. Each of us is important to him as he tells us the shepherd calls each by name.

Again, Jesus as the "gate" is an interesting image. A gate provides security for those within the enclosure. It keeps them safe. It keeps them together. It keeps them sheltered and protected. So, listening to the voice of the Good Shepherd and walking through the gate is what will lead us to the greenest pasture.
