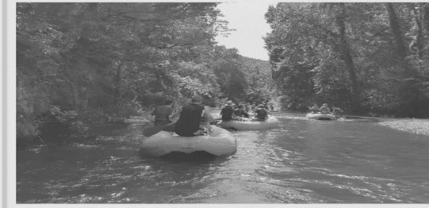
**Catholic schools in Diocese of Jefferson City will remain in distance learning mode through end of school year (May 15).**

### **FROM THE PASTOR:**

*5th Sunday of Easter (A)*

Today's gospel passage is taken from the farewell speeches Jesus made during the last supper, soon after Judas had left the room to work out the betrayal of Jesus. He knew how traumatic it would be for his Apostles when he was put to death and he told them not to let their hearts be troubled. "You have faith in God, have faith also in me". With this Jesus gives them the arsenal by which they could avoid great distress.

Going further, Jesus tells the disciples that he is 'the way'. And in the second reading from the letter of Peter, we are told that we are the living stones of the church with Christ as the key-stone. The 'way' is seen as the path leading to Easter, a difficult path because it demands the given up of one's life for the brothers. So, when we have accepted to follow the "way" of Jesus, we find ourselves in the house of the father, that is, in the Christian community. And this Christian community has many places, that is, many ministries or services; implying, there are many ways of using the gift of one's life. Therefore, the "many rooms" are nothing else than the 'different ministries, the different concrete situations where all of us have the possibility of using our strength, our capabilities in the service of our brothers and sisters. Again, every time we gather as a group of believers, people with one faith, apparently, we are showing people the way to Christ. Our gathering, our actions tell others how Christians are called to be in this world. It is in our homes, offices, and schools that we show the world what we learn from being together as a Christian community. It is outside of this church building that we are 'church- the people of God.' Proudly, we are the 'living stones' that is the church. Remember, the 'rooms', meaning the ministries or ways of serving our brothers and sisters are many so there shouldn't be room for envy, jealousy or idleness; but only those who refuse the change and newness of life from the risen Lord can remain idle.
