FROM THE PASTOR:

ASCENSION [A]

Today, we have an event that is very much related to being thrown into the air or being flown in an aircraft that goes deep into the clouds: the ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ though not into the air but into heaven. He has completed his mission by fulfilling his Father's will. So, as a good son, he has returned to render full account of his work to his Father.

In our first reading, Acts of the Apostles, Luke gives us a brief summary of the life of Jesus up to the point of his dramatic ascension into heaven. It gives us messages of hope like the promise of the Holy Spirit: "You will receive the Holy Spiritand you shall be my witnesses to the ends of the earth." This means that Christ is not leaving us as orphans. Instead, he remains with us through the Holy Spirit "till the end of time". Therefore, the ascension of Christ does not mean his absence from us, rather it means his continuous presence through the Holy Spirit. As Christ's disciples, we rejoice because we celebrate the final victory of Jesus over Satan and this world. This is a sign of hope that we too shall overcome all the forces of sickness, poverty, humiliation, injustice, and oppression that try to subdue us in this world. Ascension reminds us that we are on a journey, and heaven is our final destination. Again, we believe that He will come back again as he ascended into heaven. This means that we have to await his coming not idly gazing into the skies like those who were there on the ascension site {Acts 1:9-11}. Instead, we are advised to go about preparing ourselves by following the instructions he gave to us while he was on earth and living according to his will. Live productive lives.
