FROM THE PASTOR: *PENTECOST*

Pentecost completes the Easter season. The Monday after Pentecost returns us to weekdays of the 10th [Tenth] week in Ordinary Time. However, the solemnities the church celebrates on the next two Sunday's [THE MOST HOLY TRINITY and THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST] are solemnities in Ordinary Time; these solemnities are connected to the Easter mystery, but not to the Easter season.

Pentecost is often referred to as the birthday of the Church. It is our rebirth into new life as those re-created in the spirit. It is our celebration of being God's redeemed people who now share in the mission of the Divine Son. I think this is the great mystery we celebrate on this festival.

The disciples in our gospel today chose to flee – hiding in an upper room. Of course, they were afraid. Their teacher and Lord had been taken from them; the religious authorities did not like them. Even though Jesus wanted them to go into the world, they didn't have the slightest idea of what they would say and where they would go.

Jesus promised to send them an Advocate who would guide them and reveal the truth to them, but they didn't know what that would look like. And into that locked room, Jesus breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained." By doing so he re-creates them, bringing gifts of grace and strength they could not imagine. We are re-created by the Holy spirit. The sign of re-creation is forgiveness. The fruit of re-creation and forgiveness is peace. No wonder Jesus greets the disciples with "peace be with you" No wonder we humans long for lasting peace.

Pentecost may be the end of the Easter season, but it is also a celebration of the beginning of our new life in Christ. Therefore, we must be careful not to put away our Easter joy too quickly. Rather than our alleluias being over, they are just beginning! They bear fruit and comes to existence in the practical ways in our life that we "renew the face of the earth".
