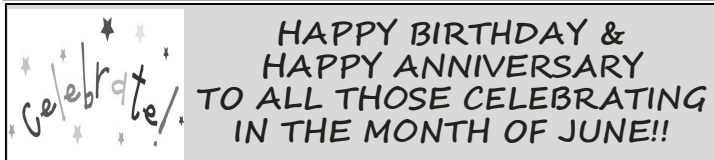

FROM THE PASTOR:

TRINITY SUNDAY

Today is Trinity Sunday. Our catholic faith teaches us that there is only one God but three Divine Persons-God the Father, God the son, and God the Holy Spirit.

Today we encounter the mystery of all mysteries, the mystery that underlies our faith and our entire spiritual lives. It is a mystery too great for many people to accept. Many people prefer having a God whom they can understand. My suspicion is that if God is someone I can completely understand, someone probably made him up. I think we should not be surprised that the God who made all things is greater than all things, including our human intellect.

To tell you the truth, this mystery of the Blessed Trinity is very difficult to explain. But we can explain this in our own experiential way. We believe the Blessed Trinity through faith and nothing more. This faith must be realized, embodied, and materialized in our concrete lives.

We tend to think we know what is best for us and for others. We rely on our experience and intelligence. Sometimes we are right; often we are wrong. When our self-confidence and power become more important than the truth and common good, we easily verge into arrogance and stubbornness. Jesus reminds us that the Holy Spirit, whom he calls the Spirit of Truth, is the ultimate guide. In choosing to follow the Spirit and accepting Christ's authority, we admit that we do not know it all and that we are not the greatest.

Our creed is built on this acceptance. From our first profession of faith, we stand in humble awareness that God alone knows it all and desires what is best for us and the whole world.

"In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." We use these words and sign ourselves in the form of a cross thousands of times. Is this merely a habit, or do we reflect on its meaning? "In the name" suggests in the possession of or protection of. The sign of the cross can be understood to be a surrender to God, a giving of our whole self to the triune God, a placing ourselves in God's loving presence. The sign of the cross also reminds us that our God is three and acts in different ways on our behalf.
