### FROM THE PASTOR:

12<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Persecution is the one word that binds together all three readings. The prophet Jeremiah lived in a very sad period of the history of his people. The Babylonians took over almost the whole territory of Israel. The king and all the military chiefs had lost control and did not know what to do. The religious leaders themselves shifted from their duties and praised the decisions of the political leaders. They kept telling the people: "Everything is all right, no evil will befall you" [Jer 6:13-14], while everything was collapsing.

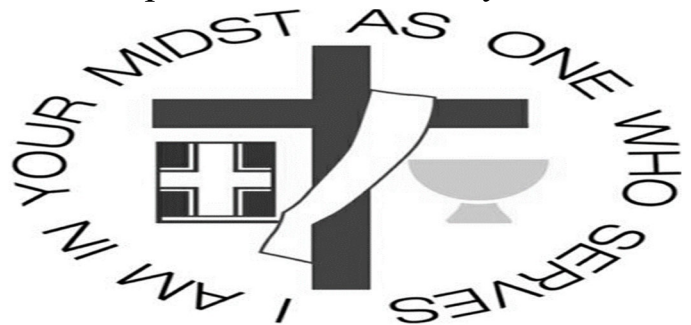
It is in this dramatic situation that the voice of the prophet Jeremiah, is heard. He is a timid man, a lover of quite life, afraid of conflicts and controversies. His dream is to go on living quietly with his family; but one day God singles him for a difficult and dangerous mission. He must go up to Jerusalem, to the political and religious leaders and tell them that they are behaving like fools, and that their religion is all falsehood and illusion.

However, Jeremiah goes up and accuses the authorities of deceiving the people and proclaims loudly to his countrymen that they are getting close to total disintegration. He says: "I see terror approaching; terror from every side!" The leaders, realizing how they were being attacked, began persecuting him. What hurts the prophet most is that he sees his best friends among the shouting crowd. It is indeed difficult to be a prophet, and too dangerous even to say the truth! It is sometimes risky to raise one's voice in protest against injustice and expose how badly things are going. But I ask, is it to flee into hiding, or to let others speak out or to pretend not to see them is the best approach? But we all know that, if today the world is a bit better, this due to the sacrifice of prophets like Jeremiah who had the courage to stand up and speak.
