FROM THE PASTOR:

15th Sunday in Ordinary Time

God is a God of abundance, not a God of scarcity. Jesus reveals to us God's abundance, when he compares his divine word to seed which a farmer goes out to sow in abundance. The parable of the sower. The seeds fall on different types of soil [heart]. And the scarcity of the fruits does not depend either on the seeds or on the sower but on the type of soil [heart] that receives it.

We have a heart as hard as the road surface that is constantly trampled on; it doesn't allow the seed of the word of God to go through. This happens to anybody listening to the Gospel without understanding it. Then we have a heart that is fickle, easily inflamed but after a few days it is back to what it was before. It is like a stone covered with a thin layer of soil. The seed that falls on it will quickly germinate but will dry up just as quickly. We have also a tormented heart that worries about all the problems of the world. All these preoccupations are like thorns that stifle the seed of the word. And then, finally we have the good heart where the Gospel produces abundant fruit. The four types of soil are to be found in our world today. In each of us we can find thorns, stones, bad roads and good soil. And so, the question that follows is: How can I improve the disposition of my heart so that the word of God can bear fruit in my life or bear fruit more abundantly? We are called to listen to and understand what we hear when the word of God is addressed to us and never allow the evil one to come and snatch away what is sown in our heart. We are challenged to see ourselves as a kind of soil, and in that respect to be good receivers of the seed God wishes to sow within our hearts. And if we are truly "good soil" we will bear abundant fruit. So dear friends, the words of Jesus are the divine seeds which give us spiritual nourishment yielding happiness and peace in abundance, depending on the kind of soil our hearts are. God is a generous giver.
