FROM THE PASTOR:

17th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Do we have the courage to sell off everything? The first reading and the gospel are joined together by the theme of the search for a great treasure. For king Solomon the greatest treasure was the wisdom to enable him to govern his people well. For us the treasure is the kingdom of God. Whoever discovers it is full of Joy and is ready to change his whole life to have it.

We are called to be like Solomon in the first reading. Solomon was king of Israel, and the one that built the first Temple. Under his rule ancient Israel attained the height of its prosperity, influence, and geographical size. At the onset of Solomon's reign, God invited him to ask for a favor. Realizing the challenges of governing the chosen people, Solomon asked for wisdom. This was what made him righteous: not that he was perfect in every way, but that he chose to love God and seek divine guidance to fulfill his duties. He could have asked for long life or material riches but rather he chose to put everything else behind and ask for one thing only- divine wisdom. His request pleased God who made him the wisest of rulers, and gave him immeasurable material riches in addition. The Lord is longing to do the same thing with us. Everyday is an opportunity for us to either pursue the things that are transitory and shallow or the one thing that really matters and lasts- communion with Christ, living life as Christ would have us. In today's gospel parables, prudence required that the cultivator and the merchant should both sell everything they had in order to gain something of far greater value. We may or may not have the material riches and pleasures of this life, but we can rest assured that, "For those who love God all things work together for good." [Rom. 8:28]
