## FROM THE PASTOR:

18th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's gospel it is important to note that Jesus does not start his miracle from nothing. He starts from the small amount that the apostles offered him. They give what little they had –just five loaves and two fish to Christ who blesses it, breaks it and gives it back to them to share. There was enough for all to have their fill and be satisfied.

We are called to share what little we have, our time, our talent, our treasure and offer to Christ. Any little we give he will make great. He will bless it, break it, and give it back to us to share with others. There will be enough for all to have our fill and be satisfied. The little we share will turn into a miracle by God's action. We have to believe that if we do the little things right, then God will make those little actions into something great. We have to find ways to be kind and gentle every day in our every single action and every single word.

Again, those who were cured and fed in our gospel today were those who took the pain to come with our Lord to that lonely place. Among the people in the crowd, it is possible that some people were discouraged at some point and discontinued. Some may have seen the search for Jesus Christ as worthless and went back with both their physical and spiritual hunger. But believe it that with God there is need to be steady and consistent. As individuals, as communities and as a world, we suffer all kinds of hunger- for food, for love, for peace. God is able and willing to satisfy all our hungers. But God is looking for men and women who believe enough to give up their five loaves and two fish, which God needs to make the miracle possible.
