FROM THE PASTOR:

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time

Have you ever tried to join a group or organization and found yourself excluded because of who you are? Maybe it was a church or sports organization. Some exclude because of race or color. Some exclude because of religion.

In today's gospel, the Canaanite woman came to Jesus for help. She believed wholeheartedly in Jesus since she called him by the messianic title, 'son of David'. But the disciples initially excluded her because she was not a Jew. They even asked Jesus to exclude her from their group! Indeed, Jesus rebuked her saying the same thing – that he had come to minister to the Israelites first and foremost. The story shows that although Jesus' mission was not to the Gentiles before he was crucified, he was not opposed to their having a full share in God's love and blessings. So the central theme of this Sunday's readings is inclusiveness. The Canaanite woman of today's gospel is the symbol of every believer [Christian] or child of God. Each of us approaches the Lord with the burden of a tormented situation. She represents what the anguished human heart needs. She teaches us today; Personal faith, persistent faith, cheerful faith. Many of our neighbors are in desperate need of the mercy, truth, and grace of God- just like the little girl in today's gospel. Our job is to connect those needy souls to Christ just as the Canaanite woman did, through our prayer, Christian living, and our concrete action.

Breaking the Silence of Abuse

As a diocese, we are committed to breaking the silence of abuse. When someone is reporting abuse, we must acknowledge their pain and how difficult it is to talk about it. False allegations are very rare. Our initial response to someone who is disclosing abuse for the first time must be compassionate. For those who need to report abuse, encourage them to contact our Victim's Assistance Coordinator, Nancy Hoey, and to make use of the appropriate State of Missouri hotline or the Attorney General's clergy abuse online form. All of this information is also on the Diocese's website, under the "**report abuse**" tab.. Missouri Bishops Statement on Amendment 2 (Medicaid Expansion)

The vote to expand the Medicaid program will provide greater access to health insurance coverage for the working poor. We are hopeful that the expansion of this important program will improve health outcomes for those with unmet healthcare needs as well as help Missouri's hospitals keep their doors open, especially in rural parts of the state.

We know that the vote on Amendment 2 came with great anxiety for some members of Missouri's pro-life community. We want to make it clear that our support for human life at all stages is unwavering. Indeed, helping those in need obtain health care is part of being pro-life and part of our call from Christ to see Him in the face of those less fortunate. We believe providing low-income working mothers with health insurance coverage that remains in place after they deliver will reduce the demand for abortions. We pledge our continued support going forward to ensuring the Hyde Amendment remains a part of federal law, and to walk with mothers in need who face unplanned pregnancies. We hope the Missouri legislature will be able to find a way to fund this important program in the face of the fiscal challenges brought on by the current health crisis.
