FROM THE PASTOR:

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

If Jesus were to ask us Today: “Who am I to You? “We would certainly answer with the words of Peter. But he would probably insist no, this is not what you think; you just heard this from others, from the priest, the catechists. But for you personally, who am I, what influence have I got on your life, what changes has your faith in me brought about in your life?

In today’s gospel, Jesus asks his disciples what others really say about him and if they really believe in him. Jesus knew that the disciples practiced their faith and Peter, who had walked with him since the beginning of his public ministry. Now he was asking if they really believed that he was the son of God, the Messiah. After Peter restated his full faith in Christ, Jesus assures him that he will build the church upon him. Today, Jesus assures us that he will continue to build the church on his modern-day disciples-that is you and me, the people of God. Hence, we are called to practice what we believe.
