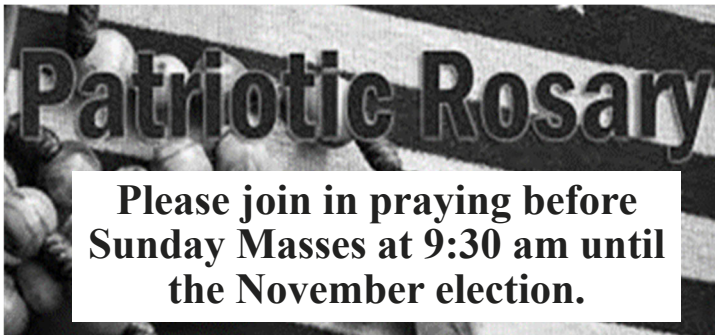

FROM THE PASTOR:

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

In our gospel today, Jesus seems to be doing an advertisement. He is selling a product. The name of this product is the kingdom of God. We can have this at the expense of Jesus because He suffered for this on the cross. He was crucified. How to acquire this as our own is through discipleship. There is only ingredient in order to become a disciple, self-denial and it entails suffering.
