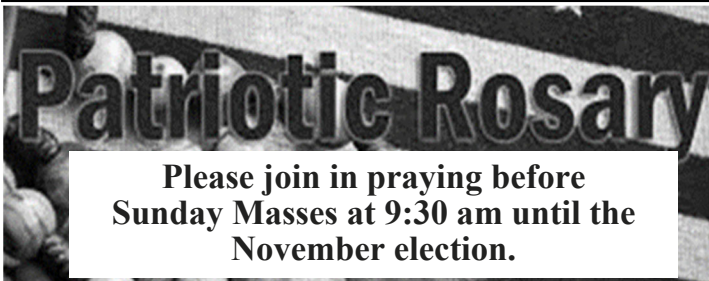

## **FROM THE PASTOR:**

23rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

**“If another member of the church sins [against you], go and point out the fault when the two of you are alone. If the member listens to you, you have regained that one”. Dear friends, the directive is that those who are spiritually stronger [the offended party] take the initiative to reach out to those who are spiritually weak [the offending and erring member]. What is at stake is how to bring an erring member back into the fold, to full reconciliation and communion with God and with us.**

Jesus tells us that we love one another when we go first to the person with whom we are in conflict. Jesus tells us that we watch out for one another when we go and resolve our conflicts quietly with each other. Jesus tells us the way we love one another is by correcting each other quietly and respectfully. “If a sinner refuses to listen even to the church, then treat him as you would a Gentile or a tax collector.” Is Jesus telling his disciples to exclude sinners? No, Jesus has already extended his mission into Gentile territory [remember the Canaanite woman] and welcomed tax collectors into his fold. So, Jesus is telling his disciples and us to realize that the goal is always reconciliation, not exclusion.
