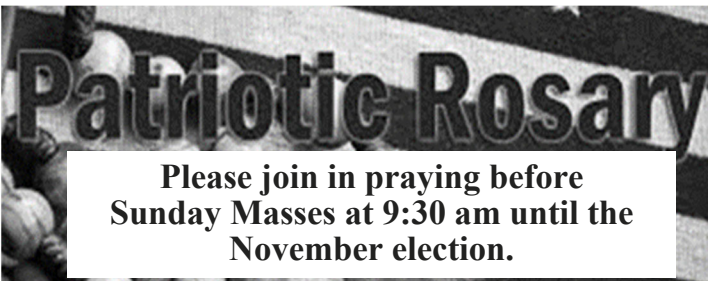

### **FROM THE PASTOR:**

24th Sunday in Ordinary Time

God, like a good mother, never punishes us for his own satisfaction, but that we may become better. God keeps no grudges against any of us. Are we ready to forgive those who have hurt us, or do we still keep our resentment fresh?

In today's gospel, Peter asks Jesus how often he needs to forgive his offenders. When Peter suggests to Jesus that forgiving one's brother or sister "as many as seven times" would be sufficient, he is suggesting that seven times would amount to total forgiveness. Jesus says not seven but seventy-seven times. In other words, every time a person offends us, we are called to forgive them. Seventy-seven is the biblical way of saying 'every time'. For Jesus, seventy-seven implies boundlessness. No completion to forgiveness. Forgiveness should be an attitude to be integrated into our way of living.

Jesus illustrates this lesson to forgive with a powerful example of the king who forgives the debt of a servant's large loan and how that same servant wrangled a small debt from a fellow servant. When the king forgave the loan, he didn't just wipe away the servant's debt, he restored him [and his family] to life. He literally gave them their life back. How disturbing it is, to see him then go out and punish the servant with the smaller debt. When we forgive others, we give them a chance to improve.
