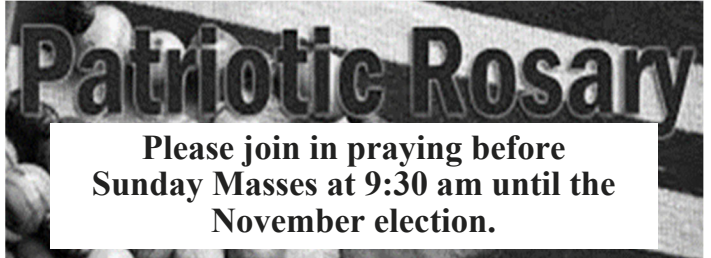

FROM THE PASTOR:

26th Sunday in Ordinary Time

God is always ready to help those who renounce evil and want to reconstruct their lives. Our gospel today is about matching our words with action. We see clearly the two possible attitudes of the Christians of today. To do the will of the father does not mean performing religious practices, but to practice the commandment of love towards our fellows.

Every day we face choices, choices between right and wrong, choices between justice and injustice, choices between life and death. Each day we are called to strive towards good. The parable today is about what you do, not what you say, that opens the door to eternal life. In Jesus' story of the last judgment, remember the king does not say to those on his right, "I was hungry and you said you would bring me food" or "I was naked and you told me you would get me some clothes." The way in our gospel, the son who does his father's will is the one who does the work, whether he said he would or not. So, what you said before is irrelevant; what is important is working in the vineyard today.

Dear friends, our faith includes expressing ourselves in prayer and ritual [i.e. using fitting word] but it also requires that we put into action the message and the commands that Jesus has given us. If we haven't been living the way Jesus has taught us, it's never too late to change things around as the young man in the gospel shows us, the son who initially said "no" to his father, but then had a change of heart.

Box of Joy is a ministry to send Christmas gifts to poor children in developing countries, and is sponsored by **Cross Catholic Outreach**. For many children, a Box of Joy - filled with toys, clothing, school supplies, a rosary, and the story of Jesus - **is the first Christmas gift they will ever receive**. If you are interested in filling a Box of Joy, box kits and gift ideas/envelopes are in all three vestibules of the church and also in the lobby by the main school office. A **donation of \$9 each** is requested to pay for shipping and to support this ministry. Our goal this year is to fill **75 Boxes by October 25th**. Capital Energy Company - CEC for Kids Program
When a church member from a participating church purchases propane from CEC **5% of their total dollar spent on residential propane deliveries received from Sept 1-March 31 is donated back with a check cut in April to the church** to be used to benefit the children in that church.
