FROM THE PASTOR:

27th Sunday in Ordinary Time

On this 27th Sunday, Year A, the church enjoys us to rejoice for being highly favored because God chose us as his beloved vineyard, as well as appointed us to be in charge of his vineyard. Considering this we are to put in our best in order not to disappoint the God who appointed us.

Today's gospel calls for responsibility and accountability in our dealings with God, which include our dealings with our fellow human beings. The parable has a lot to teach us about stewardship. We all have at least received life from God. Life is given to us in trust. We are expected to cultivate and manage this life in such a way that it bears good fruit – fruit that we can present to God the owner of our lives on the day of reckoning. Like the gospel of last Sunday, God entrusts the vineyard, the kingdom, to those who do the work and produce good fruit. Before God entrusts a responsibility to you, He makes provision for all that you will need in carrying out the responsibility.

Like the managers of the vineyard, everything we have is a privilege and not a merit. And this is what we mean when we say that everything is God's grace. Life itself is a privilege which can be taken away from any of us at any moment. So, privilege however, comes with responsibility. Let us today pray for the wisdom and the courage never to abuse our privileges but rather to make a judicious use of all the privileges and opportunities that God gives us.
