FROM THE PASTOR:

30th Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the gospel, Jesus tells the Pharisees that love of God and love of neighbor take precedence over every other commandment. The problem with the Pharisees is that they saw religion and worship only in the sphere of the mind, keeping to the rituals and observing the laws, while the heart is too far away from God. For Jesus, Loving God from the depth of our hearts and souls should come before the exercise of our human reasoning. We must fall in love with God before trying to understand his mysteries. Again, Jesus goes a little further, that we need to not only accept but love ourselves just the way we are, with all our imperfections and inadequacies, as well as all our gifts and talents. We cannot genuinely love others if we cannot love ourselves. But if we can only accept and love ourselves with our imperfections and inadequacies as well as our gifts and talents, then we will be able to love others with their imperfections and inadequacies as well as their gifts and talents. In fact, we will love others for who they are, that is, a child of God. We love God when we listen to his Word and live as he shows us. Our neighbors and their needs keep changing continually. So, to love God it is necessary to be always attentive and ready to respond to the needs of our brothers and sisters. Let us pray for the grace to treat our neighbor as we treat ourselves so that we can be like the Thessalonians, whom Saint Paul calls, "a model for all the believers".

The **OLOS School children** will once again be placing over **1000 tea lights on each gravestone in the cemetery** and **reciting the Litany of the Saints** in procession on **Friday, October 30th**, weather permitting. This has now become an annual event for our school children, one in which they look forward to and take great pride in doing. This activity is tied to a tradition originating in Germany, where people lit candles and placed them on the graves of their loved ones, letting them burn throughout the night before All Saints, representing the "light of the holy souls". **We are asking for monetary donations to support our efforts.** If you would be able to help out, please place a marked envelope with your donation in the weekend collection, drop off at school or parish office, or leave in the collection basket at the entrance of church. And remember to drive by the cemetery at night on that weekend. It is quite an amazing sight! Thank you so much for supporting our efforts to remember our friends and relatives who have passed to their eternal reward!
