FROM THE PASTOR:

Feast of All Saints

It is hard to believe it is already November. The gospel today presents a prescription for a saintly life. Jesus away from the crowds, sits down with his disciples and teaches them the path to holiness. Besides the handful of saints whose feast days we celebrate on specific days in the year, there are countless others saints and martyrs, men, women, and children united with God in the heavenly glory whom we do not celebrate. Many of these would be our own parents and grandparents who were heroic women and men of faith. Today we keep their honorable memory. In many ways, therefore, today's feast can be called the feast of the unknown saint. In fact, we celebrate what the first reading calls "A great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, robed in white with palm branches in their hands". [Rev. 7:9] Today is a celebration in which we are invited to look intently at the lives of the saints to see what faithfulness looks like. The church, in its wisdom, names saints for us so that we can strive to imitate them, strive to imitate their love and perseverance and compassion and humility and generosity. As we listen to today's readings let us pray for God's grace in becoming poor in spirit, clean of heart, and hungry for righteousness, among the other prescriptions Jesus lays out for us as his disciples. May this inspire us to pursue the ideals that are the Beatitudes during our life here on earth.
