## ***FROM THE PASTOR:***

32nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

In the gospel, Jesus is the bridegroom, and you and I, as disciples, are the bridesmaids. Whether we are wise or foolish will depend on our ability to keep our focus. That focus is none other than Christ Jesus himself. For Jesus, eternal preparedness is the price of salvation. Every disciple of Jesus must be ever prepared to meet the Lord-whenver He may come. Again, the wise ones cannot share with the foolish ones; since what is required to enter the feast must be what you have brought or what you have done yourself.

A few weeks ago, the rejected guests were those without a wedding garment, now it's the ones without working lamps. It still points to our baptism; at baptism we were clothed in Christ and were given a lighted candle. Only those who put on Christ and light the way are welcomed to the kingdom. Furthermore, we can't interpret the oil in the story too literally. If we think of it as a material object that could be shared, we're going to think how selfish of those five wise virgins. But it is something that cannot be given to someone else. It is something that we have worked for like a loving relationship with God or the good works we have done or the moral life, or wisdom we have gained through prayer and meditation. Hence, our preparedness must be characterized with these three elements: we must plan purposefully, we must prepare prayerfully, and we must pursue positively and persistently.
