## ***FROM THE PASTOR:***

Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's gospel, Jesus tells us the parable of three servants, two of whom are considered good and faithful; the third is considered a lazy person. From the beginning of the story we are told that the servant who received just one talent is a man of little ability. He is not a genius. Yet it is interesting to note that the master has a talent even for his relatively disadvantaged servant. The third, out of fear of his master, buried his one talent because he believed that the master was a demanding man. Notice also, that the master was more concerned about teaching his servants how to use their gifts productively than just earning a healthy return. Again, it seems the master was giving the money to his servants, not in order to get it back, but as a personal gift to each of them. Obviously, they didn't know that until the master said "take the talent from him [the one who buried it] and give it to the one with the ten talents."

Dear friends, all of us in the church today have received at least one talent. We have received the gift of faith. Our responsibility as men and women of faith is not just to preserve and "keep" the faith. We need to trade with it. We need to sell it to the men and women of our times. We need to promote and add value to faith. Unless we do this, we stand in danger of losing the faith just as the third servant lost his talent. The way to preserve the faith, or any other talent that God has given us, is to put it to work and make it bear fruit. So, God doesn't want back the gifts he gives us; he wants us to use them to help others.
