FROM THE PASTOR:

Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In our gospel today, we are told: “unlike the scribes, he taught them with authority”. In his ministry and by his death and resurrection, Jesus provided for all those who come to him the release from moral and spiritual weakness. How strange it seems to suggest that the scribes [and the Pharisees] did not teach with authority. The people who listened to Jesus that day in Capernaum were struck by his authority. Authority is something we all know about. Many people have exercised their authority in our lives. They influenced us in different ways. According to G. K. Chesterton: “Greatness is making others feel great!” That is what real authority does. It is growth –giving, helpful, positive, and affirmative. Authority is meant to make one grow. And that is what happened to the people when they were listening to Jesus in their synagogue. Hearing him they began to understand their own possibilities. He gave them a hope the scribes did not give them. He did not talk down to them, as the scribes were accustomed to do. In fact, He treated them as friends and equals. He didn’t flatter them.

Ordinarily, the man in the grip of a demon sounds like someone we might hear and dismiss as being seriously mentally ill. Through our baptism, we all share in the common priesthood of Christ, imbued with the authority to preach and to teach, to reconcile and to heal wounds and division. That is authority! We become more or less like Christ the more or less we utilize this authority. Remember, His living word continues to rescue us.
