FROM THE PASTOR:

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Do not think that Jesus is not interested in our material welfare. He is. But the spiritual must come first. In the gospel today, Jesus came primarily for three things: To preach, To heal and To pray. Notice that at first Jesus stays in one place and the whole town comes to him. But a few verses later, he sets out for the other villages of Galilee. Jesus, being spiritually minded person, refuses to limit His ministry to one place or to encourage the belief of a coming worldly kingdom of God, responding to Simon, He said, "Let us go to the neighboring towns so that I may proclaim there also, for this purpose have I come" [Mark 1:38].

His mission is not to sit and wait, but to go and do. He cannot stay in one place. He must go forth. So must we. In today's reading, we move from despair to hope. Job was lamenting with a note of desperation over his predicament, "I shall not see happiness again" [Job 7:7]. He has lost his health, his livelihood, his family; in fact, he has lost hope. But one thing is notable here, Job did not end his life in suffering. After passing through those challenges, God reversed his condition, and he recovered all that he lost even got more. The difference between Job and some of us is that while Job believes strongly that he has a living God who will make all things new in His time, we often forget that our redeemer lives.
