FROM THE PASTOR:

Second Sunday of Lent

Today we begin the second week of Lent with the gospel account of the Transfiguration of Jesus. He takes Peter, James, and John up mount Tabor and gives them a little glimpse of His glory. The divine glory shines from the face of Jesus. He is transformed before them or He changes in appearance when He prays to God. And then the voice of the Father from the clouds reveals who Jesus is: "This is my son, my beloved. Listen to him." God the Father reveals that Jesus is not only a man, but He is also God.

One of the intentions of this vision could be to strengthen the faith of the apostles. It is because a few days earlier, Jesus told them that He is going to suffer and die in Jerusalem. St. Mathew, in his gospel, says that when Peter heard this, he says to Jesus; "God forbid it, Lord! That must not or never happen to you." Jesus then said to Peter: "Get behind me Satan! You are an obstacle in my way, because these thoughts of yours does not come from God but from man. [Mtt. 16:22-23].

Dear friends, God is telling us to trust Him when we climb on the mountain of faith and life. We should not give up. We should go slowly, step by step. He is telling us to leave our emotional and spiritual baggage behind and travel light. If we trust Him, we will be able to let go of our worries in life. Let us like Abraham place our trust in God and respond obediently to His command.
