FROM THE PASTOR:

Third Sunday of Lent

In the gospel, Jesus cleansed the Temple of Jerusalem, and predicted about its destruction and reconstruction. In the Church of God, no discrimination is to be made; nobody should be barred, separated, or discouraged from worshipping God in it. The place of worship should not be commercialized. It is a place where people desire to pray and worship, and nothing of commercial activity should disturb or prohibit a person from praying and worshipping.

The temple according to history had five sections or courts: 1] Holy of Holies 2] Court of Priest 3] Court of Israel 4] Court of Women 5] Court of Gentiles. It was a universal house of God “for all the Nations” where every man or woman on earth would find a place in which to pray. But the Temple priest forgot that and thought that it was meant for Jews alone. So, they decided to turn the court of the Gentiles into a “Holy” marketplace for selling the animals required for sacrifice and for exchanging money. The court of Gentiles was no longer regarded as part and parcel of the house of God, it had become a marketplace. Now, it was this court of the Gentiles that Jesus cleansed. In so doing, he was making the point that the Gentile section was just as Holy as the Jewish sections. God is God of all and not God of a selected group. Jesus challenges the sense of pride that the Israelites feel from God as choosing them and the sense that they are, therefore, better than the people of the surrounding nations. In a way, he was asking them to grow up and find the humility that comes from age and spend less time in judging others. On this journey through Lent, we might need the whip of penance, fasting, abstinence, prayer, almsgiving, and some discipline to bring us back to order from the distraction of sin and disobedience.
