FROM THE PASTOR:

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord

In today's second reading Paul recounts for the Philippians what may be seen as the pattern of humility and exaltation that can be discerned in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus.

What Paul seems to be saying is that we should seek to possess the kind of "know how" that Jesus displayed in choosing a life of humility over a life of self-glorification. The radical humility that Jesus shows in his taking the form of a slave, in his willingness to follow the divine will even to the cross, is one that we are called to imitate in our own lives. It is by our imitation of the pattern of living that Jesus has set that we acquire the "know how" to face even life's daily challenges.

Dear friend's, it is a known fact that all people are born into this world to live, but Jesus came into this world to die; but it is not a passive resignation to death, rather, an active embrace of it to conquer it.

The palms that we bless and the passion that we read draws us into a drama of holy week, not merely as spectators but as participants. The palms that we hold and take home with us are signs that we are willing to march with Jesus not only in moments of triumph and glory as when He entered Jerusalem crying "Hosanna to the son of David", but also in moments of suffering and agony as when he was condemned to death with the crowd saying, "crucify him". We may or may not be called to make the kind of supreme sacrifice that Jesus made, but we are all called to make our own Jesus's prayer to the Father, "not as I will, but as you will".
