Fourth Sunday of Easter (Good Shepherd Sunday)

Today being the fourth Sunday of Easter is known as the Good Shepherd Sunday. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep. Our Lord Jesus Christ is the shepherd with a difference because He is so protective of the sheep to the extent that he lays down his life for his sheep against any external aggression.

Good shepherds are those who are lover of peace and justice, pro-life, pro-environment, those who have self-control, have courage and bravery, patience, perseverance, sportsmanship and many more. These good shepherds are ready to lay down their lives just like Jesus Christ who was nailed on the cross. Good shepherds who lay down their lives are husbands and wives who show their devotion to each other; teachers who spend untold hours instructing weak students; doctors and nurses who work untiringly to show they care for their patients. In short, this Sunday is for anyone who is the head or leader of any group or undertaking.

Jesus invites us to share in the work of caring for the flock in our own little ways.
