FROM THE PASTOR

Pentecost Sunday

Today we are celebrating the feast of the Pentecost. The third Divine Person of the Blessed Trinity sent to the world by the Father and the son, Jesus Christ. The Holy spirit now guides the church and continues the works and teaching of Jesus without changing them. He is the sanctifier of the church. The Holy spirit reminds us, that we have a mission. Our mission is to tell everyone the good news that God is theirs, that God is the Father of us all, that in spite of all the visible difference of language and culture and social status, we are all one family and should therefore live as brothers and sisters. Our mission is to break the barriers between "us" and "them" between male and female, between Jew and Gentile, between rich and poor, and to bring all humankind to speak the one universal language of brotherly/sisterly love. This is possible only through the working of the Holy spirit.

Again, Pentecost is about service. It is also about courage. The spirit gives Christians the strength and courage to bear witness to Christ in the world. In the second reading, St. Paul says: "There are varieties of service to be done, but always the same Lord; working in all sorts of different ways in different people. It is the same God who is working in all of them." Serving the Lord is what Pentecost is all about. Let us continue to serve all people without condition regardless of who he/she is.
