## FROM THE PASTOR

*12th Sunday in Ordinary Time*

A storm is always a challenge. Today's gospel recorded the story of Jesus' disciples who were on the lake of Galilee when a violent storm occurred. The terrified apostles truly sought the Lord's help. When they felt the raging storm, they were afraid that they woke Jesus up. Even though they knew that the Lord was with them, they still were consumed by fear.

And so, Jesus said to them: "Why are you afraid? Have you still no faith?" During Christ's time the lake of Galilee was notorious for its storms. And despite of its destructive effects, Christ never attempted to abolish them but just stopped them for a moment. It is not something which happened once; it is something which still happens, and which can happen to us. But in the presence of Jesus, we can have peace even in the wildest storms of life.

However, there are so many storms that break into our lives and even God permits them to enter as our warnings and reminders. One reason is, to wake us up because when our life is easy and comfortable, we do not go to Him and talk to him and respond to his will. The issue here is that we tend to call on God only when everything seems hopeless and say: "I guess all we can do now is pray." God seems to be the last one to know about our predicaments. The question today is, when are we going to learn to really trust and surrender everything to God?

Jesus says in our gospel today, "Let us go to the other side." That is, let us leave behind the past.
