Church Concrete Replacement Project

The Building & Grounds Committee has successfully overseen the replacement of the concrete in front of Church. The Parish paid \$33,442 to Stockman Construction Corporation for completion of the project. This amount included a \$6,500 deduction/donation from the company. The Parish has sent a "thank you" letter to Stockman Construction acknowledging their donation. The cost of the project was partially offset by a transfer of \$15,000 from the Building & Grounds savings account at Our Lady of Snows Credit Union and by \$5,725 in parishioner contributions from the project special collection.
