Fr. Alex on Vacation ~ On November 29, Fr. Alex will be leaving for India for about two months. The family of Fr. Alex is also planning to celebrate the ruby jubilee or 40th Anniversary of his Ordination on December 30th, 2021 exactly on the date he was Ordained 40 years ago. A very few priests in his home diocese live long enough to celebrate golden jubilee or 50th Anniversary of Ordination. So reaching 40 years is worth celebrating in his diocese. Since Covid-19 began Fr. Alex had not been able to take any vacation for more than two years. Kindly pray for his safe journey to India and back to USA.

In the absence of Fr. Alex, Diocese is arranging different priests to cover the weekend masses. But, for the whole week of Christmas and New Year, Fr. Ashok Kujur, SJ, a Jesuit priest from the home diocese of Fr. Alex, who is a PhD research Scientist at Creighton University, Omaha, Nebraska will cover at both the parishes. There will be no weekday Masses. Deacon Chet may do Communion Service on some weekdays about which information will be put in the bulletin when time comes.
