Scheduled Work Nights to Prepare for Picnic Day:

Wednesdays at 6:30 pm on August 10, 17, 24 & 31.

Come and help; you will be eligible to win a free dinner ticket.

Drawings are held each work night!

Groceries Needed: In order to offset the cost of grocery items, parish members are asked to bring in items for the Picnic. The following grocery items may be dropped off at the old parish hall after any of the weekend Masses, beginning August 13-28th: **Corn Green Beans Sauerkraut.**

The weekend of August 27-28th, or early SATURDAY morning (Sept. 3): **Potatoes**

Picnic Day: **Milk Powdered Milk Butter Pies & Desserts Bread**

Each family is asked to bring the following: **homemade bread** (sliced and put in a plastic bag), and

3 fruit pies or desserts (no cream or custard pies). Please label the pies and desserts and use disposable pans.

Please DO NOT CUT PIES.

Pie Orders: If you do not have time to bake for the Picnic, there is an alternative for you! Schulte's Bakery will make 3 pies and 2 loaves of bread for **\$25**. Write a check payable to: **Schulte's** and put in an envelope marked: **PICNIC PIES/BREAD**. You can put the envelope in the collection basket or drop it in the night deposit at Mary's Home Bank by **Monday, August 29**. This is strictly voluntary for those who do not bake or do not have time to bake. If you normally make your own pies or desserts, and bread, please continue to do so.

Homemade Pastry Auction: Held after the Quilt Fortune Wheel.

If you have a special **homemade** pastry or item that you would like to donate to the auction (examples: pies, cakes, rolls etc.), please take the item/s to the old School Basement on Picnic Day and put your name and the name of your item on the list. **THANK YOU!**

Each family is asked to donate several items for the following:

Grab Bag: \$1 KIDS items purchased new, in a paper bag, marked **B** (Boy) or **G** (Girl).

Country Store: Homemade baked items, canned items, fresh vegetables, etc.

Please label all items and mark sauces if "**Hot**", "**Mild**", type of jelly, jam, bread, etc.

Please note if your item contains nuts for allergy purposes.

Craft Stand: Handmade, fancy or craft items (big or small, including Christmas items).

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One of the definitions of an “**Active Parishioner**” of Our Lady of the Snows Parish is:
“Practices stewardship by giving of their time, talents, and tithes”.

The Picnic is a major source of income for the Parish. Unless the Parish Office has been informed of a change in parishioner status in writing, or due to age or health reasons, names will remain on the Picnic Work List.

No parishioner’s name has intentionally been left off the list. If your name does not appear and you are able to help, please contact the Parish Office. Picnic Day is a full day of work for everyone and your help is very much needed and appreciated.

**Check the list carefully, your job may have changed &
you may be assigned to more than one work shift.**

Please remember to conduct yourself in a Christian manner at all times.

MANAGERS:

Managers need to supply money aprons for their stand. Be sure to call your workers at least one week before the Picnic to make sure they will be there. All expenses for your stand must be submitted to the Parish Office for payment by September 15th with a receipt. Please write your name and what the purchase was for (meat, stand items, etc.) on your receipt for bookkeeping purposes.

Expenses should not be reimbursed from the proceeds from your stand.

PLEASE NOTE:

Stand Managers are asked to cooperate with the system that is in place for turning in money. Please *try* to take money to the Parish Office (Annex Bldg.) every 2-3 hours. A manager is welcome to stay with the cashiers while their stand money is being counted. No stand should be turning in all of their money at the end of the day.

Managers are responsible for their own equipment and are expected to store it after the Picnic. Everyone is asked to come on both Saturday and Monday to help set up and take down the stands and to clean up the Center and grounds. This is a big job, but it doesn’t take long if everyone helps.

Everyone is tired, but please try to help so clean-up doesn’t take long!

Please make sure your children are aware of their jobs and do their jobs as assigned or see that they have a replacement. ***Make sure your children are there on time and do not leave early.*** If they cannot work as scheduled, please attempt to trade shifts or find a replacement; and notify their manager **before** Picnic Day if they are not going to show up.
