

I talked to one of the sisters about it, she confirmed that God may indeed be drawing me to SSND. My parents were supportive of a possible call to religious life. Over time, I just knew I must at least give it a try and trusted I would know each step along the way. I was not disappointed, God did and continues to show me the way each day of my life.
