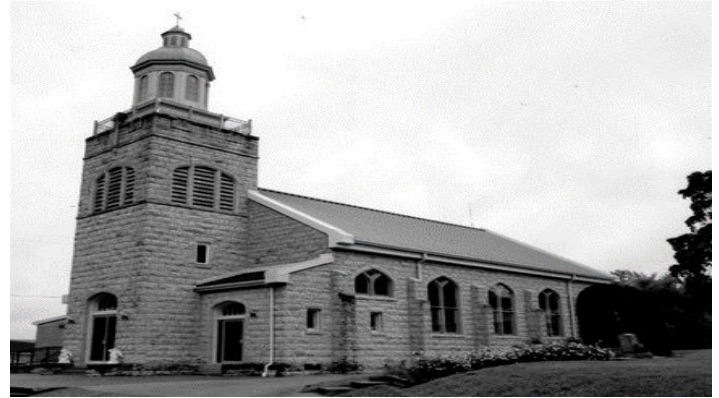

-Due to health issues, Bruce Berendzen is stepping down from the Council.

-Colleen provided the Deanery update about the Deanery Discernment Plan for the Better Together Diocesan Initiative. A survey is currently out for individuals to express what they see as needs in their parish, how they can be involved in their parish, and their thoughts on shared services and activities within neighboring parishes. Bulletin information and mass announcements and social media encouragements for the survey are scheduled. The survey will remain open until April 15. Following the survey collection, a town hall meeting will be conducted for parish members to provide additional feedback on these topics.

-There was discussion about a joint meeting with councils from Marys Home and Eldon to meet once per quarter.

-The Stewardship Council was discussed with feedback about Father Jones' message. Plans for additional information in the bulletin and announcements for additional members for the Stewardship Council were discussed. Members who have volunteered so far are Colleen Abbott (Chair), Mary Burgess, and Barb Adrian (Secretary). Many others may be interested but needed to better understand the commitment. Mary started bulletin announcements about the history of the parish and good news from parish members. There has been very positive feedback on these thus far.

-Cory brought information from the Building & Grounds. Projects planned for the church include the need for plaster and paint, new carpet, and pew renovation. This was last done 20-25 years ago. The costs and timeline were discussed. The next project will likely be the updating of the back doors of the church, including the doors on the sacristy. There was concern from B/G to make sure there is not a sentimental value of anyone for these doors. An announcement will be put in the bulletin to give people the chance to bring this up. The door update will also fix the handicap entrance.

-Following the meeting, a text was used to approve posting of a part-time secretary position.

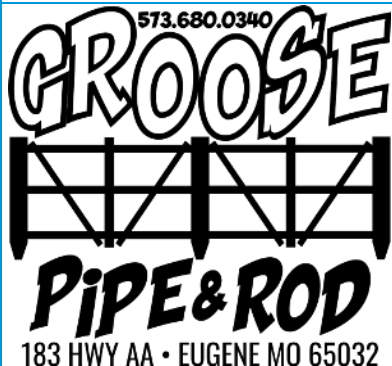
